Suncorp launches inaugural Reconciliation Action Plan

Suncorp has celebrated the launch of its first Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) at its Sydney Barangaroo office.

Suncorp CEO and Managing Director Michael Cameron said he was proud to launch Suncorp's first RAP.

"The Suncorp RAP reflects our commitment to supporting the social and economic prosperity of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people," Mr Cameron said.

"Suncorp's RAP, to be implemented over the next 12 months, provides a strong foundation to build and strengthen relationships and deepen the understanding and respect for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and achievements.

"The RAP involves programs that will improve the social and financial resilience of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians."

Mr Cameron said it was fitting to launch the RAP during National Reconciliation Week, a time for all Australians to learn more about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and histories.

Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council Director, Ann Weldon, opened the event with a Welcome to Country and Reconciliation Australia CEO, Karen Mundine, officially welcomed Suncorp into the RAP program.

Ms Mundine congratulated Suncorp on the endorsement of its first RAP, which would see it build on the key pillars of reconciliation – relationships, respect and opportunities.

"Suncorp displays a deep commitment to building and maintaining respectful relationships with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, organisations, and communities," Ms Mundine said.

"As a top 20 ASX-listed company, this Reflect RAP will assist Suncorp to develop its own unique vision for reconciliation, as well as commitments to applying cultural learning, respectful business practice, and promotion of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander employment within its sphere of influence."
